Types Of Rudraksha

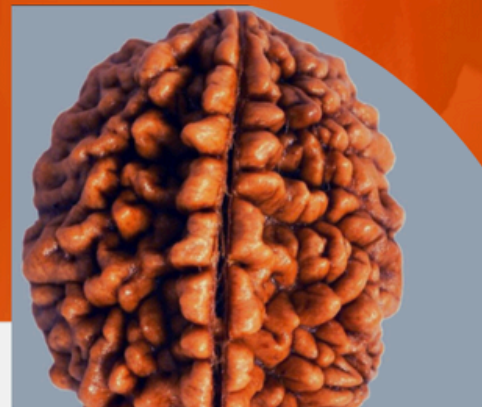
