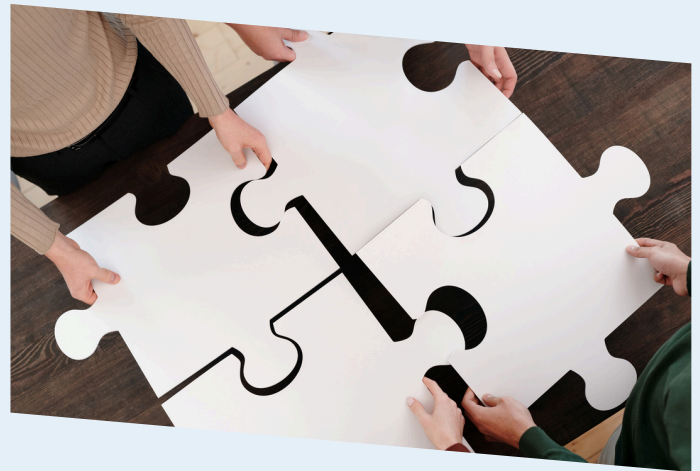
Scope Definition
