Once approved, the person is placed in a national queue. The waiting time can vary depending on demand, urgency, and availability in your area.

Step 4: Choose a Home Care Provider in Sydney

When your package becomes available, you'll receive a letter from My Aged Care. At this point, you can select a home care provider to manage your package and deliver services.
